



Central Bark Attendee Information and Rules

GrandView Animal Care Center offers supervised canine social groups to our clients and their dogs as well as non-clients. Our goal in providing these social groups is to not only enrich your bond with your dog, but to add to your dog's development. Our canine social groups are for **positive** play and socialization with other dogs and people. Therefore, if you are unsure of how your dog is going to react in an off-leash, group play session, then a consultation with Denise is the first step. Denise is a Licensed Veterinary Technician, Dog Obedience Trainer and Behavior Counselor. She has 14 years of experience and will be able to guide you and your dog in the right direction. Groups are based on your dog's age and personality. GrandView Animal Care Center and Denise Scarozza, LVT reserve the right to re-assess placement in these groups as they see fit in order to maintain a **positive** and rewarding environment for you and your dog(s).

Groups are broken down as follows:

- Large Dog (HIGH ENERGY) 9:00 am - 10:00 am
- Small Dog / Mellow Dog-all sizes 10:30 am - 11:30 am
- Puppy Group (12 weeks - 6 months) 12:00 pm - 1:00 pm

All dogs must be at least 8 months old to attend, be spayed or neutered, and be current on vaccinations.

If you are not a client of GrandView Animal Care Center, then proof of your dog's vaccination history will be required to attend.

Pricing & Payment:

- \$8.00 per 1 hour session - OR - \$35.00 for a 5 visit pass. Cost is **per dog**.
- Purchase of either 1 session or 5 visit pass can be done at the gated area outside prior to entering. It is advisable to arrive at least 10 minutes early if you need to do this. If you have previously purchased a 5 visit pass, please have your session marked off your pass prior to entering the gated area.
- We accept cash, check, Care Credit and all major credit cards as proper forms of payment for admission into Central Bark. If paying with a check, please make your check payable to GrandView Animal Care Center - or - GVACC.

Rules inside Central Bark:

- NO TREATS or FOOD is allowed inside the gated area at any time.
- Smoking is DEFINITELY not allowed within the gated area.
- All dogs are to arrive ON LEASH and remain on leash until Denise begins the session.
- You are in charge of your dogs eliminations - bring poop bags!
- Dress appropriately. Outdoor play sessions can be dirty; white is not an advisable color. :)
- BRING A TOWEL. During the summer we provide a pool for the dogs to splash in, and in some circumstances, the weather may not cooperate and leave us with a muddy park.
- BE ON TIME... If you are going to be more than 10 minutes late, it is best for the dynamics of the group that you join the group another time.

Rules outside Central Bark

- Parking may be limited. In cases where our parking lot is full, you can park next door at the Masonic Community Center in the back behind the building near the end of their lot. PLEASE do not take up spaces near the building for they host many events of their own.
- Canine Social Groups are conducted based on the weather. Denise will send out an email on Friday afternoons to all registered clients to inform you of the status of Social Groups the next day. If the temperature is over 80 degrees or below 30 degrees F, Central Bark will be closed. Rain and snow don't bother us unless it bothers you.
- If you have not already done so, please go to our website (www.grandviewpets.com) to review our Canine Social Group Agreement/Waiver. There you will be able to fill out you and your dog's information and agree to the terms and conditions. You will only be asked to sign this agreement/waiver one time.
